2012 Bella Ridge Estate Demi-Sec: New wine to our range, this wine is fresh, fun and lively. Half dry, half not with grapefruit and pear.	\$24.50
2014 Bella Ridge Estate Trebbiano: Intensely aromatic with stonefruit and pear, with a fresh, light palate.	\$24.50
2011 Bella Ridge Estate <i>old vine</i> Chenin Blanc: Rich and elegant this textural and aromatic Chenin Blanc displays generous tropical fruit and citrus flavours. Bottle age, oak and lees influences add complexity and length while the finish is round and lingering.	\$30.00
2008 Bella Ridge Estate Belle Mere: Belle Mere is produced from the 'best' white barrels from vintage 08. Aromatic and elegant Belle Mere is style focused rather than varietal.	\$52.50
2012 Bella Ridge Estate Rose: Made specifically as a Rose (not as a by-product of red wine production!) from Tempranillo grapes — complex and textured, a serious Rose!	\$27.50
2009 Bella Ridge Estate Barbera: Produced in very limited quantity this wine is full flavoured, with dark cherry, spice and 'earthy' flavours and aromas.	\$40.00
2012 Bella Ridge Estate Tempranillo: Unique Spanish style wine, rich ripe cherries, medium bodied, full flavoured with silky tannins and a long smooth finish.	\$29.50
2010 Bella Ridge Estate GSM: Bella Ridge's take on the classic Rhone Valley blend: Grenache, Shiraz & Mourvedre.	\$32.00
2009 Bella Ridge Estate Shiraz: Loaded with chocolate & berry flavours and a hint of toasty oak. A small addition of Viognier accentuates a rich & intense nose.	\$32.00
2006 Bella Ridge Estate Grenache: Produced from very old Swan Valley Grenache vines this wine has an intense nose of strawberries, dark forest fruits and subtle spicy oak	\$75.00
2006 Bella Ridge Estate Beau Pere: Beau Pere is produced from the 'best' red barrels from vintage 06. Complex and elegant Beau Pere is style focused rather than varietal.	\$52.50

2006 Bella Ridge Estate Bella Fino (375mL): A complex dry style fortified wine produced in limited quantity. Almond and orange peel on the nose and refreshing citrus on the palate. A dry refreshing long finish.	\$40.50
2006 Bella Ridge Late Harvest Viognier (375mL): Produced from late picked Viognier grapes, fermented and aged for 2 years in barrel this wine shows dried apricot and spice characters with a sweet middle palate and a long, dry finish.	\$40.50
2009 Bella Ridge Estate Bella Blanc: Made from Estate grown Chenin Blanc grapes in the traditional Champenoise Method. Just disgorged!	\$30.00

2005 Bella Ridge Estate Verdelho: A new release museum wine which is favoursome, complex and textural. It has obvious aged characters yet distinct lively freshness. "Best WA Verdelho 2016" —Ray Jordan	\$48.50
2007 Bella Ridge Estate Viognier: This is a big, full flavoured white wine. Apricot and spice combine with aromas of stonefruit and toasty oak. The palate is fresh, rich and full and the finish long and smooth.	\$46.50
2006 Bella Ridge Estate Semillon: Classic aged Semillon — hay, almond and lemon combine with a solid oak structure to deliver this complex, mature and elegant wine.	\$44.50
2005 Bella Ridge Estate Chardonnay Viognier: This wine is a unique blend of Margaret River Chardonnay and Swan Valley Viognier. 'Minerally' with citrus and spicy oak, this wine has a complex, creamy palate and full finish.	\$50.00
2004 Bella Ridge Estate Cabernet Shiraz: From our very first vintage, 2004 this wine is deep red-black in colour with ripe cherry and characteristic mint and spice aromas. It is loaded with rich plum flavours and soft tannins, has good depth and a rounded finish.	\$55.00
